

Notice of Revision to Dividend Forecast in Accordance with Share Consolidation

Tokyo, June 25, 2018 – Fujitsu Limited (“Fujitsu”) announced today that, in accordance with the proposal concerning share consolidation approved at the 118th annual shareholders meeting held today, Fujitsu revise its dividend forecast as bellow.

1. Reason for revision

The proposal for consolidation of its common shares at the rate of one share for every ten shares effective October 1, 2018 was approved and determined at the 118th annual shareholders meeting held today.

In accordance with the share consolidation, Fujitsu revise its dividend forecast for the year ending March 2019, to increase the value of the year-end dividend per share by ten, in proportion to the consolidation ratio.

The revision is intended to revise the value of the per-share dividend in accordance with the share consolidation and there is no material change in the dividend forecast.
