3. A Summary of the Announcement

Based on the trend in the Company's recent business performance, we are announcing the forecast for its Consolidated Operating Performance for the fiscal year 2020.

With regard to dividends, the forecast is \$110 per share for both interim and year-end dividends; thus, the total annual dividend for the fiscal year 2020 will become \$220 per share, an increase of \$20 compared with the previous fiscal year.
